She was an apprentice. She had taken her witchery exams, but they still hadn't sent a letter. Had she passed or not?

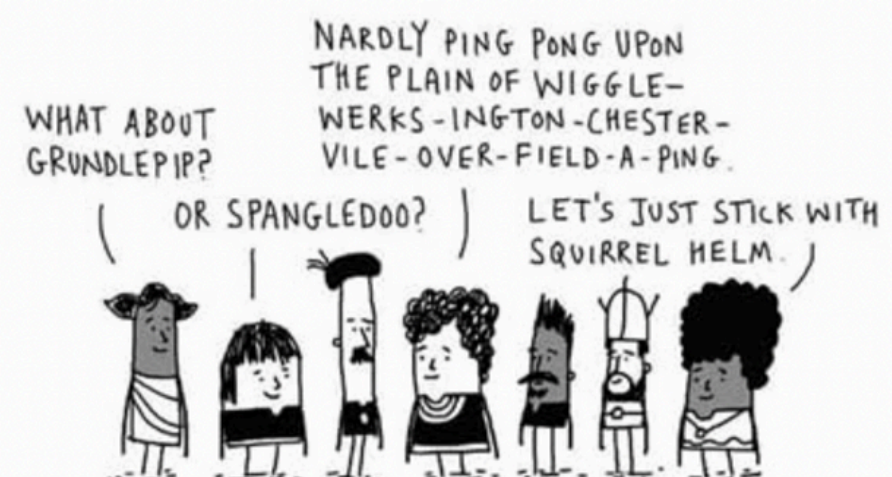
It was awful having to wait for the results.
